

2022 JUVENILE APPOINTMENT LIST ORIENTATION SESSIONS

Local Juvenile Rule 4.2(B)(3) requires that all applicants for any of the Juvenile Court Appointment Lists attend a general orientation session in order to be eligible for placement on the lists. Further, to be included on List 7a (Family Recovery Court) and/or List 7b (Juvenile Recovery Court), an attorney must attend an orientation session particular to the Franklin County Specialized Docket Programs.

The general orientation sessions and the specialized docket sessions are scheduled *quarterly*.

The primary purposes of the general session are to familiarize applicants with the requirements for submitting bills and discuss the general requirements and rules for the appointment lists. The purpose of the specialized docket sessions is to acquaint potential List 7a and 7b attorneys with the processes and function of the specialized dockets.

The general session starts at 12:00 (noon) and lasts approximately one hour. The Specialized Docket session begins at 1:00 p.m. and lasts approximately 45 minutes.

The sessions are held in the Large Conference Room on the 6th floor of the Court. Attendees should check in with the receptionist in Administration (past the appointed counsel billing office and CPO desk) and will be directed to the Conference Room.
