ENTRY/ORDER FOR MEDIATION SERVICES

Pursuant to Local Juvenile Rule 17, it is hereby ORDERED the parties shall participate in a mediation assessment and, if determined appropriate, at least one mediation session.

Parties shall contact the Dispute Resolution Department within ten (10) business days to complete mediation intake, screening, and scheduling.

Failure of a party to complete intake or attend mediation may result in a delay of the case, dismissal of the non-participating party's complaint/motion, or the Court may impose other sanctions at its discretion.
