First Cause of Action

2151.03.A (2) Neglect

Child(ren) who lack adequate parental care because of the faults or habits of the child(ren)'s parents, guardian, or custodian; to wit:

Second Cause of Action

2151.03 A (3) Neglect

Child(ren) whose parents, guardian or custodian neglects the child(ren) or refuses to provide proper or necessary subsistence, education, medical or surgical care or treatment, or other care necessary for chil(ren)'s health, morals or well-being, to wit: The complainant hereby incorporates the allegations of the first cause of action as if repeated verbatim herein.

Third Cause of Action

2151.04.C Dependency

Whose condition or environment is such as to warrant the State in the interest of the child in assuming guardianship; to wit: The complainant hereby incorporates the allegations of the first and second causes of action as if repeated verbatim herein.

COMPLAINT

RE:

Persons having custody and control of children

(Wherefore, complainant prays this Court to so find the child(ren) and make a disposition pursuant to 2151.353 O.R.C. including but not limited to an order of temporary custody and/or of long-term foster care as would be in the child(ren)'s best interest and any other relief the Court finds appropriate.

NOTICE TO PARENTS

YOU ARE HEREBY ADVISED THAT THE GRANTING OF PERMANENT CUSTODY OF THE ABOVE NAMED CHILD(REN) PERMANENTLY DIVEST THE PARENTS OF THEIR PARENTAL RIGHT AND PRIVILEGES. IF FRANKLIN COUNTY CHILDREN SERVICES OBTAINS PERMANENT CUSTODY OF THE ABOVE-NAMED CHILD(REN), THE PARENTS WILL HAVE NO LEGAL RIGHTS TO THE CHILD(REN). AT THAT TIME, THE CHILD(REN) MAY BE PLACED FOR ADOPTION.

ANY PARTY IS ENTITLED TO BE REPRESENTED BY COUNSEL IN THIS PROCEEDING IF YOU WISH TO BE REPRESENTED BY AN ATTORNEY AND YOU ARE INDIGENT (UNABLE TO PAY FOR AN ATTORNEY), THE COURT WILL APPOINT AN ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT YOU.
